**4. Action Items for Next Meeting**

- **Sharrows:** Peter will talk to Village liaison, Tom Rocco, about the next steps. The BPC wants to ensure the following:
  - The paint used will be of high quality so as not to fade
  - NATCO design specifications are used in placing/painting the sharrows
  - Around the time sharrows are painted, we should contact the *NP Times* so they can write an article about sharrows and their location
- **Road Repair Letter:** Peter will send the letter to the various DPW contacts
- **Coalition Building:** A list of potential groups/individuals was generated. Peter will draft an outreach letter and circulate it to the BPC for consideration and discussion at our next meeting
- **Worst Roads for Biking and Walking:** BPC members will make a list of the most dangerous/unfriendly streets for biking and walking in New Paltz. The BPC will then distribute this list to elected officials and DPW contacts. An article in the *NP Times* should also be considered
- **Complete Streets Ordinances:** Peter will circulate to the BPC Complete Streets Ordinances from other NY municipalities. The BPC will consider making a request to the Village and Town to consider adopting a Complete Streets ordinance
- **Night-time Visibility Campaign:** The BPC will come to the next meeting with potential ideas for an education campaign/initiative for altering people about the dangers of being out at night without any lights or reflectors
