He reported that signs warning about the contaminated state of the Wallkill will be put up before the Wallkill Regatta. Riverkeeper says that the Wallkill is the most contaminated Hudson River Tributary. The project will be to improve the Wallkill from Sturgeon Pool upstream to Orange County. Seven municipalities have passed expressions of support. There will be a Conference on *The Future of the Wallkill River* on April 23rd at SUNY New Paltz. A registration link will be open soon on the internet.

5. Gunks Climbing Coalition presentation jointly to CWOSP and EnCB:

Peter Cody of the Gunks Climbers Coalition, a climbers group involved with stewardship of climbing areas and an affiliate of the Access Fund, addressed the EnCB and CWOSP Comm. regarding his group's desire that Minnewaska State Park Preserve enlarge the rock climbing opportunities there, particularly on areas where there was climbing before the land became a park. Peter said that the Park administration is reluctant to undertake management of expanded climbing, believing that additional staff would be needed. He hoped that the Town of New Paltz would give a letter of support for expanded rock climbing. It would involve getting back country permits to cliffs that were not now accessible, such as Gertrude's Nose, Hamilton Point, Castle Point, to Sam's Point. There was some discussion, and the general sense of the people there was supportive.
