Seth said he would take the document, insert his changes which had been left out by earlier editors, and review the other edits and changes, get Michael Zierler to contact K.T. Tobin to get her most important edits to make the plan more useful for grant writing, and have the plan ready to send to the rest of the Commission before August 8th. Then it can be reviewed and forwarded to the DEC, and also the Town and Village for their adoption. Richard Feisel said he wanted the plan to be more explicit about the benefits to the local people of the proposed Preserve.
