What to do if You Test Positive with an At-Home Rapid COVID Test





- PS/
- Follow the manufacturer's instructions for administering the test.
- Take a picture of the positive at-home test result within 24 hours for the Department of Health.
- Report positive test results to the Department of

 Health online at covid19.ulstercountyny.gov/hometest
 or by calling (845) 443-8888.
- Self-isolate: have separate living and bathroom facilities from the rest of your household members
- Consult a doctor or go to the ER if symptoms worsen or you have trouble breathing
- A public health nurse will contact you. Answer the phone to unfamiliar numbers.
 - While antigen tests are reliable, it is possible to receive a false negative. If you test negative, and
- have symptoms, take another test within 24-48 hours.
