He indicated that Police Department does track and compare it to determine if there is a connection to other graffiti in the area. The responsibility ultimately falls on the property owner to get it covered up, although there currently is no law. Sometimes volunteers will work on cleaning it up and sometimes the offenders will be required to clean it.
