- 1. The meeting began at 7:02 pm with introductions.
- 2. Mr. Ford made a motion to appoint Ms. Sanchez as Chair of the Commission. Ms. Fitzpatrick seconded, all in favor, the motion passed.
- **3.** The Commission agreed to keep the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday of the month at 7:00 pm as the set meeting date for the Commission.

- 7. Ms. Rahaman-Bunce moved, Mr. Ford 2<sup>nd</sup> to adopt the following framework for future Police Commission agendas:
  - 1. Call to Order/Welcome
  - 2. Public Comment
  - 3. Approval of Minutes
  - 4. Monthly Report from the Chief of Police or designee
  - 5. Other Business

All in favor, the motion passed.

- **8.** There was a discussion regarding recommending trainings for the Police Department and what the reach of the oversight commission entails.
- **9.** There was a discussion regarding officer mental health and the need for wellness counseling and respite.
- **10.** There was a discussion regarding community outreach.
- **11.** The Commission would like to see traffic stop data on the population level, such as local/out of state residents and full-time residents/students.
