Acceptable Items

Acceptance guidelines may change based on space availability or quantity.

Building Materials

We accept a wide variety of building materials in reusable condition.

- Windows should be intake and double pane.
- Unused roofing shingles.
- Unused lumber.
- Unused insulation
- Unused tile (ceramic or vinyl)
- Lighting fixtures
- Fasteners
- Doors
- Cabinets
- Plumbing and Heating – ducts, metal pipe, connectors

Household & Miscellaneous

We accept a wide variety of unbroken household goods in clean, reusable and working condition.

- Art Supplies – Matting, frames, etc.
- Lamps
- Vases
- Baskets
- Sporting Goods

*All items listed may be properly recycled or disposed of at the Town of New Paltz Recycling and ReUse Center at 1-3 Clearwater Road, New Paltz. For more information, call (845) 255-8456 or visit www.newpaltzreuse.org for further information.

The ReUse Center **DOES NOT** accept household hazardous materials (HHW), such as flammable liquids, toxic waste, chemicals, paint, used thermostats, used smoke detectors, or thermometers. These materials may be disposed of by contacting the UCRRA (845) 336-0600 or www.ucrra.org for details.

Unacceptable Items

New Paltz does not accept recalled items

Building Materials

We do not accept:

- Moisture damaged, cracked, broken, rotted or warped lumber or plywood
- Lumber shorter than 6' or plywood less than ½ sheet
- Glass shower doors
- Doors with broken panels or cut unevenly
- Windows with missing or broken glass
- Single light window sashes
- Cabinets with missing or broken doors
- Used carpet
- Used, broken, chipped, or stained tiles
- Incomplete aluminum storm doors or windows
- Hazardous, toxic or combustible materials
- Recalled items
- Car parts or car related items - **SCRAP METAL container**

Household Items and Miscellaneous

- Toys or puzzles*
- Cribs, strollers, car seats*
- Clothes or shoes*
- Blankets or bed linens (donate to local SPCA)
- Curtains or Venetian blinds
- Books/Audio/video tapes*
- Personal care items (hairbrushes, nails care) **DISCARD**
- Office cubicles, mattresses, box springs, couches, upholstered chairs

***Place in CLOTHING COLLECTION BOX ON SITE**

Appliances including but not limited to: Humidifiers, air conditioners, air purifiers*, Microwaves*. Prices vary for proper disposal at the Recycling Center

Computers & Electronics

*TVs, Cable incompatible TVs, Console TVs, Black and white TVs, laptops, computers, DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment. ***Recycle E-WASTE for FREE**
Fluorescent bulbs - **\$1 each for disposal**

Automotive Items: *All tires, batteries, engine parts, oil and fluids
