In 2005 he took over as chair for the fifth "Business Expo" for the Chamber held at the Fair grounds and succeeded in making it the best attended Expo to date. He served as a board member on The Arts Society of Kingston for 2 years and was then elected to President for an additional 2 years. He presently is a board member on the New Paltz Community Foundation. A non profit organization who's mission is to enhance the quality of life in the New Paltz region by helping raise monies for worth while projects within the community.
