## Planning Board Projects Status:

- Dunkin Donuts/250 Main Street Site Plan Changes. Nothing consequential from an environmental perspective seen. No comment at this time.
- Lot Line Revision between lots 19 and 21, Evergreen Lane development. No issue seen.
- Trans Hudson Mgmt. Corp application for Route 299 & N Putt Corners Rd proposed CVS pharmacy and gas station: We would suggest impervious aboveground gas tanks. Traffic will be a disaster. Exit/entrance on North Putt too close to traffic light, will exacerbate backups. Widen roadway, put exit farther up North Putt Corners Rd. We want to know what is planned for the rest of the property. Propose green roof, low cost/maintenance. Will nearby wetlands be affected? Re stormwater plan, 500 GPD seems ludicrously low. We will want to see updated stormwater plans. Rhett nominated Libby to write a letter with our comments.
- EnCB liaison report of PB mtg (John): John is not present.

## Discussions

- Ulster County Environmental Management Council: Jim went to the last meeting. From 1999 to present Smiley Research Center records show the annual average temperature rose 4 degrees at Mohonk. Robins, vultures and other species are no longer heading south for the winter. The ice-over date for the lake is now 27 days later on average. The lake is losing a lot of water due to the heat increase.
