

**Town of New Paltz Historic Preservation Commission Meeting

Minutes

Meeting started at 7:30. The order of our agenda was modified to accommodate a presentation by Geraldine Buck.

1) New Business

a) Geraldine Buck presented photos and shared interesting stories to support her request to have her house located at 49 Libertyville Road designated as an historic landmark. The house which was built in 1832 is associated with the Fresh Air Movement and is clearly historically significant. Mary Ann Colopy agreed to assist Geraldine with the designation process. Geraldine will be responsible for gathering and submitting an inventory of items and related artifacts to support the landmark designation.

b) Helen Christie agreed to follow-up with Paul Brown to determine location of the 'Gate House' referenced in recent discussions with the Planning Board. John Orfitelli will look for National Landmark registration documentation.

2) Follow-ups from Prior Meetings

a) Helen Cristie agreed to assist resident Terry Sullivan with the designation process. Terry approached the Commission to request her property be designated as a historic landmark. Helen will contact Terry to discuss the process which involves creating an inventory of items and related artifacts along with the property description and history.
