WHEREAS, the Town has and maintains a New Paltz Police Department (here referred to as the "Department"); and

WHEREAS, among its purposes and obligations, part of the Department's mission is to protect and to serve the health, safety and welfare of the community and to create and maintain a feeling of security within the community of New Paltz; and

WHEREAS, the Town of New Paltz has previously entered into agreements with the New Paltz Central School District to provide to the school district police personnel at school sponsored events for the purposes of providing security for the benefit of its administration, employees, students and the community at large; and

WHEREAS, the Town and the School District desire to enter into a new agreement for the 2017-2018 academic year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Supervisor (or Deputy Supervisor) be and the same hereby is authorized to sign on behalf of the Town an "Intermunicipal Agreement for Police Security Services", in the form attached, said agreement to be effective upon the

adoption by the New Paltz Central School District and by the Town of New Paltz Board of Police Commissioners of resolutions to the same effect.
