RE: MOBILITIE, LLC'S SMALL CELL RIGHT OF WAY PERMITTING

Dear Kathy Preston,

I am writing to present a revised proposal based on feedback from the Town Board in February. Based on feedback from the Town Board we are seeking to either co-locate our wireless facility to an existing utility pole or build a new pole within the town's right-of-way. Below is more information about Mobilitie and our proposal.

NEW PALTZ PROPOSAL


Mobilitie would like to install one small cell site within the town of New Paltz's right-of-way, either through collocation or the building of a new pole. The proposed location and alternative location is on Cherry Hill road, near two large commercial shopping areas. These areas have a high concentration of users pushing the capacity of the macro sites nearby reducing the service for Sprint customers. The purpose of the small cell site along Cherry Hill road is to increase the capacity of this dense commercial area and offload this capacity to existing macro sites. Based on feedback from the Town at the Public Hearing's we are proposing a new pole and a possible alternative of attachment to existing utility pole.

Cherry Hill Road Site (collocation): The proposed facility would be co-located on an existing wooden utility pole in the right-of-way on Cherry Hill Road, southwest of the Cherry Hill Road and Main Street intersection. The existing pole is located next to Pasquale's restaurant, at 248 Main Street. Mobilitie's equipment would be mounted to the side of the existing pole and a three-foot antenna on top of the pole. Enclosed is a map of the proposed location and photo simulation of the site.

Cherry Hill Road Site (new pole): The proposed facility would be a new wooden utility pole in the right-of-way on Cherry Hill Road, further southwest than the collocation facility option. The proposed location is near the office building at 3 Cherry Hill Road. The facility would include a 45-foot wooden utility pole with equipment attached to the pole. Enclosed is a map of the proposed location and photo simulation of the site.

Mobilitie is seeking the Town's input on the proposal. Mobilitie will work closely with the Town to determine the optimal locations that balances that guide the use and management of its rights-of-way.
