

**Resolution No. \_\_\_\_ of 2018**

**URGING** the Ulster County Public Works Department to establish a 30 mph speed limit on Cedar Lane, a road between Route 208 and Plains Road in the Town of New Paltz

**WHEREAS**, the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) has the authority to establish speed limits on state highways, county, and town roads, and

**WHEREAS**, Cedar Lane, a residential street between Route 208 and Plains Road is a popular route for bicyclists and other Rail Trail visitors, and

**WHEREAS**, the area speed limit on Plains Road is marked as 30 mph but Cedar Lane is unmarked,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Town Clerk is authorized to transmit this resolution to the County Commissioner of Public Works of the County of Ulster, asking the Department of Transportation to establish a maximum speed of 30 mph on Cedar Lane, a Town road pursuant to Section 1622.1 of the Vehicle and Traffic Law, and 2) complete a TE9a form with the NYSDOT.
