NOTICE OF ADOPTION
(Grievance Day)

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing was duly given and said hearing was duly held in the Town Hall of the Town of New Paltz, Ulster County, New York, on the _____ day of _____, 2016, at _____ o'clock in the afternoon of that day to consider the adoption of Local Law No. ___ for the year 2016 entitled: "A LOCAL LAW TO REPEAL ARTICLE VII OF CHAPTER 127 OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF NEW PALTZ."

The local law repeals the town's prior adoption by local option of a local law changing the date customarily referred to as "Grievance Day" to meet and hear complaints in relation to real property assessments with the result that "Grievance Day" for such purpose will be held on the fourth Tuesday of May as provided for pursuant to the provisions of subdivision 1 of §512 of the New York State Real Property Tax Law.

Copies of the Local Law are on file in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of New Paltz, where the same may be inspected during office hours.

The local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.

NOW, THEREFORE, PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, after due consideration and deliberation, the Town Board of the Town of New Paltz duly adopted said Local Law.
