Proposals received after the above date and time will not be opened and will not be considered. The Town is under no obligation to return unopened bids. Proposals should be placed in an envelope securely sealed and labeled “Surplus Equipment Bid” with the date of opening noted. A “Non-collusive Bidding Certification” must accompany all proposals.

Notwithstanding any other provisions of this document, the Town reserves the right to award surplus equipment to the highest bidder. Further, the Town reserves the right, for any or no reason, and in its sole absolute discretion, to (1) amend in whole or part, withdraw or cancel this document, and (2) accept or reject any or all proposals prior to final sale for any or no reason and with no penalty to the Town.
