Section 1. The Code of the Town of New Paltz is amended to add a new Chapter 132, "Weight Limits" to read as follows:

## CHAPTER 132

## WEIGHT LIMITS

§132-1. Trucks over certain weights excluded.

Trucks, tractors, tractor-trailer combinations, tractor-semitrailer combinations, tractortrailer-semitrailer combinations and other motor vehicles having a gross weight of ten thousand pounds (10,000 lbs.) are hereby excluded from the town highways described in the following schedule:

Old Mill Road	From its intersection with Henry W. DuBois Drive generally northerly to its intersection with Waring Lane
Waring Lane	From its intersection with Henry W. DuBois Drive generally northerly to its intersection with Old Mill Road
Lent Drive	From its intersection with Waring Lane to the terminus of Lent Drive

## §132-2. Exemptions.

The above exclusions shall not be construed to prevent the delivery or pick-up of merchandise or other property along the highways from which such vehicles are excluded.

§132-3. Penalties for offenses.

A. Any person violating any of the provisions of any of the sections of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be guilty of a violation as defined in Article 10, § 10.00, Subdivision 3, of the Penal Law of the State of New York, which shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed the sum of \$100 or imprisonment for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days, or both, for conviction of a first offense; for conviction of a second offense, both of which were committed within a period of one year, punishable by a fine not less than \$250 nor more than \$350 or imprisonment for a period not to exceed fifteen (15) days, or both; and upon conviction for a third or subsequent offense, all of which were committed within a period not to exceed the state \$350 nor more than \$500 or imprisonment for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days, or both. However, for the purpose of conferring jurisdiction upon courts and judicial officers generally, violations of this article shall be deemed misdemeanors, and, for such purpose only, all provisions of law relating to misdemeanors shall apply to such violations.

<u>Section 2</u>. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

<u>Section 3</u>. To the extent that this local law may be found to be inconsistent with any provision of the New York State Town Law, or any special law, the Town Board declares that it is its intent that this local law shall supercede any such inconsistent provision in order to effectuate the purposes of this local law.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
