**WHEREAS** the Town Board authorized and approved the Henry W. Dubois Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements Project (P.I.N. 8762.48) (“Project”); and

**WHEREAS** the Town's consulting engineer, Alta Planning + Design, Inc., has advised the Town Board that the proposed Project is an Unlisted Action in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA); and

**WHEREAS** by resolution dated the Town Board designated itself as Lead Agent for SEQRA review of the proposed Henry W. Dubois Pedestrian and Bicycle Improvements Project (P.I.N. 8762.48); and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board in the capacity of SEQRA Lead Agency for the Project, has reviewed the SEQRA Short EAF for the Project; now therefore, be it

**RESOLVED**, that the New Paltz Town Board determines that no significant adverse environmental impacts are likely to result from the proposed Henry W. Dubois Pedestrian and Bicyclist Improvement Project (P.I.N. 8762.48) and such determination is reached after careful consideration and analysis of the proposed action and the EAF for the proposed action; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board hereby authorizes and directs the Town Supervisor to complete the Environmental Assessment Form by checking the box indicating that the proposed action will not result in any significant adverse impacts; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that the Town Board approves a SEQRA Negative Declaration - Determination of Non-Significance and authorizes and directs the Town Clerk's Office to file any necessary documents in accordance with the provisions of the general regulations of the Department of Environmental Conservation; and be it further

**RESOLVED**, that this Resolution shall take effect immediately.
