NEGATIVE DECLARATION RE:
ELTING MEMORIAL LIBRARY BALLOT PROPOSITION 2023**

The following resolution was offered by _____, who moved its adoption, seconded by _____, to wit:

WHEREAS, there has been filed in Office of the Town Clerk, Town of New Paltz on July 5, 2023 a petition pursuant to Section 259, subdivision 1,b (1) of the Education Law of the State of New York by the Board of Trustees of the Elting Memorial Library requesting that the following question be placed upon the ballot and voted on at the next general election of the Town of New Paltz to be held on Tuesday, November 7, 2023:

“SHALL THE ANNUAL CONTRIBUTION OF THE TOWN OF NEW PALTZ PROVIDED IN ITS BUDGET FOR THE ELTING MEMORIAL LIBRARY, A FREE ASSOCIATION LIBRARY, LOCATED AT NEW PALTZ, NEW YORK, BE INCREASED BY SIXTY FIVE THOUSAND (\$65,000) DOLLARS ANNUALLY TO SEVEN HUNDRED TWENTY ONE THOUSAND (\$721,000) DOLLARS ANNUALLY”

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the Town Board of the Town of New Paltz has compared the proposed action as described in the Environmental Assessment Form Parts One and Two with the list of criteria set forth in 6 NYCRR 617.12 and determined that the application proposed is a Type II Action and as such the Town Board has no further responsibilities under the Act.
