- ____ Adequate, even depth provided
- ____ Heavy use areas still covered
- _____ Rubber surfacing intact
- _____ Blow off rubber surfacing material weekly or as needed
- ____ Remove graffiti immediately when found
- ____ No tripping hazards seen
- ____ All concrete anchors/footings are covered

EQUIPMENT

- ____ No rotten or splintering boards
- ____ Check all moving parts for excessive wear
- Check to ensure that no more than two treads are protruding at any bolts
- ____ No loose nails/screws/bolts/parts
- ____ No sharp edges or protrusions
- ____ Chains and ropes in good condition
- _____ No rusting, bending or warping parts seen
- ____ Railings, treads and hand holds in place
- ____ No worn bearings, all parts lubricated
- No damaged, unsuitable, loose or unstable equipment
- ____ No chipping paint
- ____ All 'S' hooks properly closed
- _____ All slides are straight and smooth
- ____ No gaps noted on slide
- _____ Swing parts and chains are in good condition
- ____ All swings are soft, not metal or wood
