a. Purpose of the proposed project:
 This project is designed to augment the existing water supply for the Village of New Paltz, New York with an additional 130 gpm source operated under a variable rate permit to aid in supply.

b. Description of current site conditions:
 The project site consists of forest, wetlands, stream, and a community building with associated structures.

c. Proposed site changes:
 Installation of two (2) water production wells, water treatment shed, and water main to connect the treated water to the existing water distribution system. Where the alignment crosses NYS Route 32 the pipe will be horizontal directional drilled. Withdraw water for purpose of water supply under a variable rate permit, with allowable withdrawal rates ranging from 0 to 130 gpm.

d. Type of structures and fill materials to be installed, and quantity of materials to be used (e.g., square feet of coverage, cubic yards of fill material, structures below ordinary/mean high water, etc.):
 Small concrete block structure to be installed of approximately 256 square feet
