Agreement For Expenditure of Highway Money

Agreement between the Town Highway Superintendent of the Town of New Paltz, Ulster County of New York, and the Undersigned members of the Town Board. Pursuant to the provisions of section 284 of Highway law, we agree that the monies levied and collected in the Town for repair and improvement of Highways and replacement of equipment shall be as follows.

GENERAL Repairs. The sum \$40,460.60 shall be set aside to be expended for the primary work and general repairs upon 59.25 miles of Town Highways, including sluices, and guide rails, including bridges having a span of less than five (5) feet or renewals thereof.

PAVMENT INPROVMENTS. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvements of Town roads.

- A. Cannon Road. Commencing County Rt. 6 and ending at its terminus. 1.79 miles (9451.2 ') there will be the expended sum of \$206,306.70. Type 3 binder paver placed, Width of travel 22' X 9451.2
- B. Dug Rd. Commencing at Springtown Road and terminating at Cannon Rd. 1.06 miles (5602') There will be the expended sum of \$126,410.40 Type 3 Binder paver placed, Width of travel 22 X 5602'
