Agreement For Expenditure of Highway Money

Agreement between the Town Highway Superintendent of the Town of New Paltz, Ulster County of New York, and the undersigned members of the Town Board. Pursuant to the provisions of section 284 of Highway law, we agree that the monies levied and collected in the Town for repair and improvement of highways and replacement of equipment shall be as follows.

General Repairs. The sum of \$ 132,021.83 shall be set aside to be expended for the primary work and general repairs upon 59.25 miles of town highways, including sluices, and guide rails, including bridges having a span of more than (5) feet or renewals thereof.

Pavement Improvements. The following sums shall be set aside to be expended for the permanent improvements of town roads.

- A. **Plutarch road.** Commencing at Old RT. 299 and ending at its terminus. 3.69 miles (19,483.2') there will be the expended sum of \$448,040.00 dollars Type 12.5mm Top and T/L course thickness set at 2."
- B. **Old Tschirky Rd.** Commencing at State Rt. 32 North and terminating at state Rt.32- 0.42 miles (2217') there will be the expended sum of \$45,000.00. dollars. Type 6 blacktop at 2" thickness with a type 3 binder T/L coat
- C. **Sarafian Road.** Commencing at county Rt. 17 (Jansen Rd.) and terminating at Dubois Rd. 0.38 miles (2006.4') there will be the expended sum of \$47,000.00. dollars. Type 6 blacktop including T/L coat.
