Section 1.

Subdivision A of Section 133-2 of the Code of the Town of New Paltz entitled “Schedules; adoption of regulations” is hereby amended to include upon the schedule of designated highways appearing within such subdivision and as part of Section 133-5 of the Code of the Town of New Paltz the following highways:

Old Route 299	From its intersection with North Ohioville Road generally westerly to its intersection with the municipal boundary between the Town of New Paltz and the Town of Lloyd.

Section 2.

Section 133-5 of the Code of the Town of New Paltz is hereby amended to include the following highways upon the schedule of streets upon which trucks, tractors, tractor-trailer

combinations and other motor vehicles in excess of the maximum gross weight limit of ten thousand pounds (10,000 lbs.) are excluded:

Location

Old Route 299

From its intersection with North Ohioville Road generally westerly to its intersection with the municipal boundary between the Town of New Paltz and the Town of Lloyd.

Section 3. If any clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section 4. To the extent that this local law may be found to be inconsistent with any provision of the New York State Town Law, including Sections 274-a, 274-b, 276 and 277, or any special law, the Town Board declares that it is its intent that this local law shall supercede any such inconsistent provision in order to effectuate the purposes of this local law.

Section 5. This local law shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Secretary of State.
