## Solar at the Landfill:

Janelle Peotter and Ted Nitza of the Ad Hoc Committee provided an update on the project. They indicated that there has been progress towards the lease agreement with Sol Systems. It is probable that the developer will be able to utilize more of the landfill and less of the wooded area. The goal is to have the lease agreement to the Town Board to vote on by December 5<sup>th</sup> in order to take advantage of the 2019 tax credits, which will decrease in 2020.

### **Resolution-Enter into Contract for CCA:**

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to adopt the resolution authorizing the Supervisor to sign the contract and enter into the Municipal Energy Services Agreement with Joule. Seconded by Councilman Irwin, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

### Selection of vendor for GASB 34:

A motion was made by Councilman Brownstein to hire CBIZ Valuation Group for the GASB 34 Fixed Asset Valuation Project, based on the Comptroller's recommendation. Seconded by Councilwoman Seyfert-Lillis, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

## Discussion of Worker's Compensation costs and consultant:

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to authorize the Supervisor to hire Disability Management Associates, Inc as a consultant, based on the Comptroller's recommendation. Seconded by Councilman Torres, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

## Discussion-Water and Sewer Meter Conversion:

Due to the installation of new water meters and new billing procedures for Town water/sewer customers, the Town Code needs to be updated to reflect the changes. The Board will work with Joe Moriello to prepare a draft law in order to set the public hearing.

#### **Resolution- Moriello Bridge Replacement**

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to adopt the resolution declaring the Town Board Lead Agency and Determination of Non-Significance under SEQRA for the Moriello Bridge Replacement. Seconded by Councilman Brownstein, all aye vote cast, motion carried. Seconded by Councilman Irwin, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

#### **Resolution-Greenway Grant/Town Open Space Plan:**

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez for the Town Board to submit a letter of support and authorize the Supervisor to sign any documents required to submit the grant. Seconded by Councilman Torres, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

## **<u>Close Public Hearing:</u>**

At 7:47 p.m. a motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to close the public hearing on the 2020 Town Budget. Seconded by Councilman Irwin, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

#### Budget discussion:

The current tax increase reflected in the preliminary budget is 6.67% as a result of changes made at the last Board meeting.
