Police Reinvention Reform Committee:

Esi Lewis, Committee Spokesperson, indicated the Committee will be meeting with various community groups and residents in the new year and will be working on Town Law Chapter 150 and Qualified Immunity. Councilwoman Baer suggested reaching out to the Latino groups as well.

<u>Climate Smart Communities Annual Report:</u>

Amanda Gotto reviewed the Committee's 2020 Report of Activities. Some highlights included Bronze Certification achieved by the Town and Village in March as part of the New York State Climate Smart Communities Program. As well as the Committee's new actions toward a Silver Certification. The Task Force has been meeting on the third Monday of the month. The Committee has been discussing topics such as Plant Based Foods, Measuring Your Carbon Footprint, Climate Smart Voting and many others as part of its' Education and Awareness outreach. Members of the Committee have also been working on related activities on other Boards and Committees such as Bike-Ped, EnCB, Planning Board, Ad Hoc Solar and many others.

Bike-Ped Discussion:

Supervisor Bettez and Mayor Rogers wrote a letter to the New Paltz Times hoping to clear up some confusion regarding the speed limit on Henry W. DuBois. The speed limit will not increase, it will remain at 30 m.p.h. Per NYS Law, a Town and Village cannot lower a speed limit below 30 m.p.h.

SEQR Resolution-Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Study (NY EPG No. 94026):

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to adopt the resolution declaring the Town Board Lead Agency and a Type II action, Neg Dec. Seconded by Councilman Brownstein, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Resolution to designate authorized representative:

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to adopt the resolution to designate an authorized representative and appropriate minimum local match regarding grant agreement. Seconded by Councilman Brownstein, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of New Paltz (Town) desires to enter into a Grant Agreement with the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation regarding the Town's Engineering Planning Grant Application Number 94026 for a Sanitary Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Study as part of the 2019 Consolidated Funding Application process;

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of New Paltz desires to designate Supervisor Neil Bettez as authorized to execute a Grant Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of New Paltz desires to authorizes and appropriates a minimum (20%) local match as required by the Engineering Planning Grant Program (EPG) for the 'Town of New Paltz Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Study'. Under the EPG program, this local match must be at least 20% of the EPG grant award of \$80,000. The source of the local match, and any amount in excess of the required match, shall be Administrative and Technical Force resources (in-kind staff/labor) and certain expected legal, materials and equipment uses. The maximum local match shall not exceed \$16,000 based upon a total estimated maximum project cost of \$96,000. The Supervisor may increase this local match through the use of in-kind services without further approval from the Town Board.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of New Paltz Town Board hereby

Designates that Supervisor Neil Bettez is authorized to execute a Grant Agreement with the NYS

Environmental Facilities Corporation and any and all other contracts, documents, and instruments necessary to bring about the project and to fulfill the Town of New Paltz's obligations under the Grant Agreement. **Declares** that the Town of New Paltz authorizes and appropriates a minimum (20%) local match as required by the Engineering Planning Grant Program (EPG) for the 'Town of New Paltz Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Study'. Under the EPG program, this local match must be at least 20% of the EPG grant award of \$80,000. The source of the local match, and any amount in excess of the required match, shall be Administrative and Technical Force resources (in-kind staff/labor) and certain expected legal, materials and equipment uses. The maximum local match shall not exceed \$16,000 based upon a total estimated maximum project cost of \$96,000. The Supervisor may increase this local match through the use of in-kind services without further approval from the Town Board.

Walden Environmental Contract:

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to authorize the Supervisor to sign the Walden Environmental contract for proposed Sewer Inflow and Infiltration Study (NY EPG No. 94026). Seconded by Councilman Torres, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to authorize the Supervisor to sign a letter to authorize closing the Town of New Paltz Community Partnership checking account. Seconded by Councilman Torres, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Review and set public hearing for revised CWOSP law:

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to set the public hearing to amend Ch. 44 for December 17th at 7 p.m. Seconded by Councilwoman Seyfert-Lillis, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

At 8:56 p.m. a motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Councilman Torres, all aye votes cast, motion carried.
