

Police Commission Meeting July 16, 2020, 6:30 PM Video Conference

At 6:35 pm a motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to approve the Police Commission agenda changing executive session to number one on the agenda. Seconded Councilwoman Seyfert-Lillis, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Executive Session:

At 6:36 pm a motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to go into Executive Session to discuss personnel. Seconded by Councilwoman Seyfert-Lillis, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

At 6:40 pm the Town Board came out of Executive Session and announced that no action was taken.

-Tanya Marquette: Wanted to know how the Town Board is addressing the criticism regarding the mission statement and reviewing stakeholders list. -Edgar Rodriguez: Discussed anti-racism groups throughout the community to be considered by the Town Board.

Councilman Torres reiterated the fact that original mission statement came from the Governor's Executive Order, which laid the framework for this initiative. He emphasized the importance of self-selection of the groups and was open to group suggestions and welcomed recommendations.
