

Public Hearing-2021 Budget, 7 p.m. Town Board Meeting November 5, 2020 Video Conference

<u>Present:</u> Supervisor Neil Bettez, Councilwoman Alex Baer, Councilman Dan Torres, Councilwoman Julie Seyfert-Lillis and Councilman Brownstein.

At 7:01 pm a motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to open the Public Hearing on the 2021 Budget. Seconded by Councilwoman Seyfert-Lillis, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Public Input: None. Public Hearing left open.

Town Board Meeting

At 7:03 Supervisor Bettez opened the Town Board meeting with the pledge.

Agenda: +Request that the Village add 59 N. Putt to Water District #1 A motion was made Supervisor Bettez to approve the agenda as amended. Seconded by Councilman Brownstein, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Public Input:

Lagusta Yearwood and Daniel Schneidewind spoke in opposition of the waivers requested by Trans-Hudson.

Executive Session:

At 7:15 p.m. a motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to go into executive session to discuss litigation. Seconded by Councilman Torres, all aye votes cast, motion carried. At 7:44 p.m. a motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to come out of executive session with no action taken. Seconded by Councilwoman Baer, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

NPCCC building maintenance:

Supervisor Bettez indicated there is a problem with the alarm system at the child care center and it needs to be disconnected along with the electricity. As a result, there will be no fire alarm which means the whole building will physically need to be disconnected from Duzine School. Highway Supt. Marx will hire an electrician and eventually start taking the building apart. The long-term plan involves dismantling the whole building because it is not safe.

Budget discussion:

Supervisor Bettez indicated that after all the cuts were made, the amount to be raised by taxes reflects a 1.56% increase for a total of \$10,160,308, which meets the tax cap. Revenues are down 25.9% from last year. The Board will close the public hearing and adopt the budget later in the meeting.

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to approve the transfer of \$320.00 from the NPPD seized asset account to purchase and install side running boards on marked unit 340. Seconded by Councilwoman Seyfert-Lillis, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Appointments to ZBA:

Tabled until 11/18. The Board would like to hear from the Chair regarding the recommendations.

Review and audit of Homeland Towers fees:

Supervisor Bettez indicated there may have been some confusion regarding documents obtained through a Foil from Homeland Towers. They were looking for an audit of the Planning Board and Attorney fees, by the Town Board. They feel the fees are exorbitant and open-ended and hope there will be on-going management of the fees. The Town will send them the coversheets to the vouchers that Board members audit on a monthly basis that show they have been reviewed.

Resolution-Records Retention Schedule:

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of New Paltz that the Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government Records (LGS-1), issued pursuant to Article 57-A of the Arts and Cultural Affairs Law, and containing

legal minimum retention periods for local government records, is hereby adopted for use by all officers in legally disposing of valueless records listed therein, and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, that in accordance with Article 57-A:(a) only those records will be disposed of that are described in Retention and Disposition Schedule for New York Local Government Records (LGS-1), after they have met the minimum retention periods described therein;(b) only those records will be disposed of that do not have sufficient administrative, fiscal, legal, or historical value to merit retention beyond established legal minimum periods.

Seconded by Councilman Torres, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Resolution-HWD SEORA:

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to adopt the following resolution:

WHEREAS the Town Board authorized and approved the Henry W. Dubois Drive Bike & Pedestrian Lane Project (P.I.N. 8762.48), Town of New Paltz, Ulster County, and

WHEREAS the Town's consulting engineer, Alta Planning + Design, has advised the Town Board that the proposed Project is an Unlisted Action in accordance with the rules and regulations of the State Environmental Quality Review Act (SEQRA), and

WHEREAS by Resolution No. 74 passed on July 30, 2020, the Town Board indicated its wish to be Lead Agency for SEQRA review of the proposed Projects and authorized and directed the Town Supervisor to send a copy of the Short Environmental Assessment Form Part I, along with a certified copy of the Resolution stating the Town Board's intention to be Lead Agency, to any and all communities or agencies that it is necessary to give written notice to in accordance with New York State Town Law, including the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, New York State Department of Transportation, New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation, and the Village of New Paltz, and

WHEREAS, notice was provided to those agencies and over 30 days have passed and the Town has received one response from the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation indicating that the Department concurs with the Town's intent to become the Lead Agency for the action, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board is duly designated to act as SEQRA Lead Agency and, in that capacity, has reviewed the SEQRA Short EAF for these Projects; now, therefore, be it

 $\textbf{RESOLVED}, that the \ New \ Paltz \ Town \ Board \ designated \ itself \ as \ Lead \ Agency \ for \ SEQRA \ review \ of the \ proposed \ Henry \ W. \ Dubois \ Drive \ Bike \ \& \ Pedestrian \ Lane \ Project \ (P.I.N. \ 8762.48); \ and \ be \ it \ further$

Seconded by Councilman Brownstein, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

MOA-Shared Planning/Zoning Secretary:

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to authorize the Supervisor to sign the MOA for shared Planning/Zoning secretarial services with the Village. Alana Sawchuk will be the Planning and Zoning Secretary for the Town and Village. Seconded by Councilman Brownstein, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Request to Village:

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez for the Town Board to request the Village Board expand Water District #1 to include 59 N. Putt Corners. Seconded by Councilwoman Seyfert-Lillis, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Budget cont.:

At 8:18 p.m. a motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to close the public hearing on the budget. Seconded by Councilman Brownstein, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

A motion was made by Supervisor Bettez to adopt the 2021 Budget. Seconded by Councilwoman Baer, all aye votes cast, motion carried.

Councilman Torres announced that the Open Space referendum regarding the Transfer Tax passed on election day.

At 8:24 pm a motion was made by Councilman Brownstein to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Supervisor Bettez, all aye votes cast, motion carried.
