3. Support having the town and village endorse Complete Streets.

- 5. The **pedestrian walk lights** are working now on Putt Corners / Main Street. They're working too at Lowe's / South Street.
- 6. Judy will submit letter in support of **e-bikes in the Mohonk Preserve**. Mike supports waiving the fee for anyone who bikes to the trailheads.
- 7. Dan will reach out to **Pat Ryan** to invite him to a Bike/Ped meeting as soon as possible after the election on Apr 30.
- 8. Judy: let's put the planning of a meeting with New York State Department of Transportation on the agenda for next month. Let's have another meeting with Sandra Jobson about need for more crosswalks, among other needs. Let's research other crosswalks like ours. Judy wants to know what the specific plan for protected lines at Zero Place was that the Department of Transportation rejected.
